Daniel Clark owned property in Highland County as early as 1810 and was a resident of Buckskin Twp., Ross Co., in 1820. Daniel and Elizabeth had 12 children. He died in 1849 and was buried just across the county line from his home in the Old Burying Ground in Greenfield. Elizabeth lived in her Ross County home until her death in 1861, when she was buried beside her husband in Greenfield.

All of the Clark's children except the youngest, Margaret, left Ohio for Iowa, Illinois and Missouri. Several of the children lived out their lives in the same western counties as several siblings. Margaret married and lived out her life in Fayette County, OH.
